Statement of findings

This award was made in June 2019.

The TEF Panel reviewed the provider metrics and provider submission according to the process and criteria specified in the TEF guidance.

The provider metrics supplemented by the submission indicate that students from all backgrounds achieve outstanding outcomes. In particular, the Panel noted that for full-time students, rates of progression to employment or further study are exceptionally high and above the provider's benchmark, with similarly high rates of progression for part-time students. For full-time students, levels of satisfaction with assessment and feedback, and academic support are exceptionally high and above the provider's benchmark; part-time students are highly satisfied with academic support. Rates of progression to highly skilled employment or further study are exceptionally low and below the provider's benchmark for full-time students. The Panel judged that this was fully addressed in the submission.

The Panel considered the provider's submission and supplementary metrics, where appropriate, in relation to the TEF criteria and its judgement reflects, in particular, evidence of:

- highly effective systems of support for students progressing internally on to higher education programmes
- comprehensive systems of student representation and communication that secure the highest levels of engagement and active commitment to learning and study
- an outstanding personalised approach to learning and academic development
- embedding of key skills in programmes to deliver vocational and sector-specific skills and knowledge that are most highly valued by employers
- a wide range of opportunities for students to engage directly in developments at the forefront of professional practice.

Overall, the TEF Panel judged that the combination of evidence in the provider metrics and the provider submission best fits the descriptor for a Gold award.
