Units

Learners will learn about play and learning including how to plan activities to meet children's individual needs and the practical skills and knowledge to support and prepare colleagues within the workplace by preparing a positive learning environment for children and young people.

Learners will be assessed in the classroom in a variety of ways. This includes written work (using Google Classroom), creating displays and carrying out professional discussions to demonstrate a deeper understanding of their knowledge.

Level 3 qualifications require learners to carry out external assessments alongside those marked internally.
