The T Level Qualification is split into 2 component parts:

Core Component:

The knowledge and underpinning concepts, theories and principles as well as core skills for the education and childcare sector.

The Occupational Specialism:

Providing you with knowledge and skills required to achieve competence as an 'Early Years Educator'.

Learners will be required to undertake an industry placement in an Early Years setting for a minimum of 21 weeks (750 hrs).
