### **About This Course**

The VTCT (ITEC) Level 3 Certificate in Access to Aesthetic Therapies is a beauty therapy qualification aimed at learners with no formal background in beauty therapy training, who wish to gain access to additional study of advanced therapy treatments at levels 4 and above.

With the ever changing beauty industry regulations it is mandatory that regulated qualifications will be recognised.

### **What Will I Study?**

This qualification consists of units at level 2 and 3 combined to provide the learner with the required underpinning knowledge, to afford direct progression onto specific modality training at level 4 +. Learners must achieve the mandatory units:

- Maintain health and safety in the salon
- Skin analysis and facial skincare
- Consultation and client care
- Anatomy, physiology and pathology

- Electrical science

Throughout this qualification learners will develop their knowledge and understanding of relevant health and safety requirements, anatomy, physiology, pathology and electrical science alongside skin analysis and safe practice treatment protocols for facial skin care. Learners will also develop the knowledge, understanding and skills required to consult with clients, and provide specific aftercare and home care advice.
