- **Interactive Media & Social Platforms:** Explore the use of interactive media, from websites to social media. Create content for the digital world.
- **Research & Inspiration:** Investigate artists, photographers, and media creators to find inspiration and understand the wider creative world.
- **Examples of production:**
  - Media** – Music Video, Advertisement, Poster, Magazine covers.
  - Photography** – Studio photography, Traditional processes, Product, portraiture, Nature, Wildlife.
